Letter with directions from Dadi Prakashmani

Beloved BapDada's children and the instrument sisters and brothers who are running Baba's centres, please accept love and remembrance from Madhuban

Beloved BapDada says: The call of the time now is 1) Become a bestower. 2) Be merciful. 3) Imbibe qualifications according to your aim 4) Constantly stay in limitless happiness. 5) Experience pleasure yourself and also give others the same experience.

From time to time, BapDada gives the signal: Children, there are and there will be many adverse situations in the world, but you have to maintain an elevated and great stage. You have to remain unshakeable and immovable like Angad. At present, we continually hear the news that in some places there are the natural calamities and in some places there are wars etc. There is also a lot of stealing because this period is now very tamopradhan and also the intellects of people are tamopradhan. Therefore, I am writing this letter to all of you today to draw your attention to a few things

All of you must also be hearing in the news that around 31st December 1999, due to the microchip design, there is a possibility of many types of problems. Bharat is expecting the countries abroad to be giving a lot of attention to this. The governments of many countries abroad have also announced that each citizen should stock enough food and drink, clothes, drinking water etc. because if around 31st December 1999, something does go wrong because of the microchip, then there would be a negative impact on these things and also in being able to purchase them. The government has also announced that every citizen should keep enough cash with them because all the banks could also be effected by something, and it would then be impossible to draw any cash from the banks.

Beloved BapDada has explained to us about all these things in advance: Children, a time will come when you will not get even a drop of water. At such a time there will be a lot of stealing and robbing etc. Even so, Baba says: Children, you are all aware of these things and therefore there is no need for you to fear or worry about anything. However, it is essential to be careful and to remain cautious. With this thought in mind, I am writing a few things which you should pay attention to. You have been cautioned about this previously also, but I am still writing to you again that you should all have a stock of essentials for at least 2 to 3 months. You should keep these things in stock either before December or after December according to your convenience.

- 1. Stock up drinking water very well. If you are able to do some boring at your place, then you can have a hand-pump, so that even when you don't have electricity, at least you have some means of drawing water. In any case, a hand pump is better for drinking water and water to be used for cooking.
- 2. You should have enough cash to cover the expenses of the centre drawn from your bank to last you fo at least one or two months. Also, have enough cash with you so that if you are unable to draw any money from your bank in December, you should already have purchased sufficient stock. Rameshbha has also suggested that if you have any money in a fixed deposit, you should transfer some of that to savings account so that you are able to draw it whenever you want.
- 3. In the last week of December 1999 and the first week of January 2000, everyone should try to hav yoga bhatthi programmes at their own places. It is with the power of yoga that you are able to develop the power of your mind, that is, you are able to increase your will-power and at the end it is this stag that will help us to become karmateet.
- 4. A special signal is being given to all of you that BapDada will come on that evening, according to the programme, and many brothers and sisters from different places have been given their turn. However, I would still like to especially advise all of you that you should only make a programme to come to Madhuban after having carefully considered the environment and circumstances wherever you are. If you are able to come and meet BapDada in the turn before or after 31st December, than that is even better. Please be specially careful that there the sisters are not alone at the centres, and you should

also make sure that you don't leave your centre empty and go to another Gita pathshala nearby. It wi also be very good if you do not hold any exhibitions or public programmes so that all brothers ar sisters are able to stay in their homes. You may go to the centre for morning class, but it would t best if you did not go touring or sightseeing during the day.

Try and buy all the necessary things for your centre as soon as you receive this letter. 5.

You may have gas for cooking, but also keep a stock of coal, kerosene, paraffin for cooking and if yo have vehicles, then also keep enough stock of diesel or petrol. If it is suitable for the bigger centre you can also keep bicycles etc.

The centres who keep their accounts in the computers should get a print out of the full accounts 7.

If electricity is cut off, then have candles, kerosene lamps and little earthen lamps for light handy wi 8. you. Torches are also an essential item with enough batterics to last some time. Also keep some bas essential medicines in stock.

It would be good if no new centres or Gita Pathshalas were opened in these three to four months. A 9. of this conditions are signalling us to attain our perfect stage through the powerful spiritual endeavor

10. You have already been told about the pilgrimage of all the jyotilingums in Bharat and some place which are very far have already begun their pilgrimage in November and others will do so i December. This unlimited programme had already been planned beforehand and if any necessar changes need to be made for the first week of January, then this will be also be done.

You should inform all the centres, sub centres, Gita Pathshalas and brothers and sisters from your class of these things so that all of them are able to collect all of these basic items for their homes.

Baba always says: Children, you have to keep yourselves ever-ready at every moment. However, if any o you have any questions or would like some help, then you can write to your main centre.

I hope that you will be able to understand these signals, but there is really no need to have any fear (anything. For us, whatever happens, it will be nothing new. But even so, I am once again writing a list of all the basic things needed numberwise.

Lentils, rice, flour, herbs and spices, milk powder, tea and sugar, cooking oil, paraffin, petrol, keroser. lamps, matches, candles, torches, essential medicines, warm woolen clothing, comfortable slippers, an most important of all, the treasures of knowledge of Baba's murlis, some literature, magazines, cassette etc. Students also should keep all these facilities so that they are able to study them when the time comes,

BapDada continues to give us signals for everything from time to time. Now, BapDada will come on 15 November after Diwali. These small signals have been given for the end of December. Now let us see wha happens in the new century. It is my pure desire that the arrival of the new century will be in the form of beautiful century.

Special note:

It is my pure desire for all of you instrument servers, brothers and sisters who are the protectors of thi sacrificial fire of Rudra, that if there is any problem or obstacle at any of the centres due to one reason c another, then you will end that obstacle peacefully and lovingly with the awareness of belonging to on Baba and none other. Create an atmosphere of such pure and powerful remembrance that the rays of thi yoga spread everywhere in all directions. All the neighbours of the centres should also receive such powerful vibrations that when the time comes, the drums of victory will beat.

It is my pure hope that all of you will read this letter filled with pure wishes with attention and keep yoursel and the yagya created by Baba very safe. However, ultimately, Baba is our Support and our Protector and will always be so. Achcha.
